

SHESHEQUIN TOWNSHIP Regular Meeting Minutes April 20, 2026

Chairman Lafy opened the meeting at 6:30pm: Attendees, Chairman Kurt D. Lafy, and John Smith, member. Joe Richter was not present. Also, present was secretary, Lori Kepner. Visitors present were, Laura Hewitt, Jonathan Sensenig, John Sensenig, Basil Bacorn and Cathy Cook. Basil was present and gave the Board updates on the library. The Sensenig's were present to ask questions for the Miller property and subdivision.

Approval of Minutes: The March 16th, 2026 Regular Meeting A motion by Smith was made to approve the minutes; seconded by Lafy and all agreed. There were no amendments to the agenda.

Reports: The Road Master provided written report. They have started working the roads to prepare them for oil. The road oil price this year is \$2.11 per gallon that does not include the trucking costs. The price of \$50.00 per 50 extra feet will remain the same for any additional road oil purchased. The sealed bids were received for Anti-Skid. Smith made a motion to accept the lowest bid for AS-1 antiskid of \$16.78 per ton from Wysox Sand and Gravel. Lafy seconded and the all agreed. The board received one sealed bid for Fuel Oil delivery of 9000 gallons from Welles Mills of .20cent over rack price. Lafy made a motion accept this fuel bid. Smith seconded and all agreed. Richter was not present at the meeting so the board tabled the purchase of two new trucks.

There was nothing new with the EMC, or the Website. We had not received a written report from the SEO. Lafy would like Library added to the report section of the agenda.

There was nothing new to report on permits.

New Business: The board reviewed the EMA Hazard Mitigation Resolution. Lafy made a motion to pass the resolution. Smith seconded and all agreed. The county is still reviewed their EMS plan for ambulance coverage throughout the county.

Old Business: There is nothing new on the Solar ordinance. There is nothing new with the Employee manual

The financials were received and reviewed by the Board. A Lafy/Smith motion passed to accept the Treasurer's Report and approve bills.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:11pm by Lafy.
