

SHESEQUIN TOWNSHIP Regular Meeting Minutes March 16, 2026

Chairman Lafy opened the meeting at 6:30pm: Attendees, Chairman Kurt D. Lafy, and John Smith, member. Joe Richter was not present. Also, present was secretary, Lori Kepner. There were several members of the public present, the attendance sheet will be included with the minutes. There were multiple members of the public present to discuss what was needed on their properties for building permits, septic permits and anything that BC Planning would require of them; most were from the Miller family along with friends of theirs. The board went over all the contact information for the residents to use and tried to answer any of the questions they had. The board did remind them that they don't govern the SEO decisions since they are the ones certified with State to provide permits or Code Inspections Inc, because they are the ones certified to issue building permits for the Township in the State. BC Planning regulates all subdivisions and land use regulations as well not the Township. George Smith was present to suggest to the board some ways they could save on budget items. One suggestion was not to put dust oil down this year. The board will discuss his suggestions at a later meeting.

Approval of Minutes: The February 17th, 2026 Regular Meeting minutes and the February 25th, 2026 Special Meeting minutes. A motion by Smith was made to approve the minutes; seconded by Lafy and all agreed.

Reports: The Road Master provided written report; they have been plowing and sanding as needed. The board discussed cinders, fuel, and dust oil for this year. Lafy made a motion to bid out 1500 ton of As-1 antiskid for the township and 9000 gallons of Diesel Fuel delivered. Smith seconded and all agreed. Richter was not present at the meeting so the board tabled the purchase of two new trucks. There was nothing new with the EMC, or the Website. We had not received a written report from the **SEO.**

There was nothing new to report on permits.

New Business: The Dirt and Gravel meeting is March 18th, 2026 at the Wysox Fire Hall, the Psats convention is April 19th-22nd this year. The County has accepted and passed their Hazard Mitigation Plan and would like the Townships to show their support by passing their participation in the County Plan by Resolution. The resolution will be ready for the board to review at the next township meeting.

Old Business: Just a reminder the Spring Cleanup is proposed for April 11th, 2026. There is nothing new on the Solar ordinance. There is nothing new with the Employee manual

The financials were received and reviewed by the Board. A Lafy/Smith motion passed to accept the Treasurer's Report and approve bills.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting at 7:50pm by Lafy.
